Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial or non-financial companies. • Our affiliates include financial companies with a Bank of Montreal or BMO name; and financial companies such as BMO Bank, N.A.
Non-Affiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. • BMO Family Office LLC does not share with non-affiliates so they can market to you.
Joint Marketing	 A formal agreement between non-affiliated financial companies that together market financial products and services to you. BMO Family Office LLC does not share with non-affiliates so they can market to you.
